Victoria Bassetti is senior advisor and senior counsel at States United Democracy Center, a new pro-democracy law firm and think tank founded by Governor Christie Todd Whitman and Ambassador Norm Eisen. She pioneered research into the recent election subversion trend and anti-democratic candidates taking over election administration posts. She is also the co-host of Yahoo News' top news podcast, *Skullduggery*. Before joining the center, she was a fellow at the Brennan Center for Justice at the New York University School of Law. She is the author of *Electoral Dysfunction* and a contributing author to *This Is What Democracy Looked Like* and the forthcoming *Overcoming Trumpery*. She was what Senator Chris Murphy described as his "co-pilot" on his recent book *The Violence Inside Us*.
